Campus Placement Report

The campus recruitment process began by orienting students on the process of Campus Placement procedure followed at St. Xavier's Institute of Education.

Campus Placement program included

1. Mock Interview session

Vice principal of SXBA High School Mr. Savio D'Mello conducted the Mock Interview session for the student teachers on 7th February, 2019. The mock interview session was conducted to increase and prepare students handle the school interviews with confidence.

2. Interview guidelines

a. Communication Skill

Staff in-charge Dr. Vini Sebastian conducted the session and helped student teachers to increase their communication skills during the interview process. Students were provided tips on verbal and non-verbal communication skills and also tips on how to display their talents and worth.

b. Resume Writing

Staff in-charge Ms. Priti S. explained and gave tips to students on how to write effective resume. Students were provided with few links to draft effective resume.

c. Dress & Etiquettes

Staff in-charge Dr. Vini Sebastian also oriented students on dress code and appropriate ways of grooming on the Campus Placement Day.

3. Orientation on International Boards

Mr. Montwyn D'Costa (Head of St. Stanislaus High School) oriented students on International Boards. The session basically focused on increasing student awareness about how ICSE, IG and IB boards function, exposure to the curriculum in different boards, expectations out of student teachers on different boards, working conditions, professional growth and career opportunities and pay scales in different boards.

4. Orientation on Prospects in Higher Education

Dr. Sybil Thomas (Professor, Department of Education, University of Mumbai) oriented student teachers on Professional Development and prospects in Higher Education. Student teachers could take up Post Graduate courses in Education where students could pursue M.Ed (Department of Education) or M.A (IDOL) in education from University of Mumbai. Student teachers could also enroll themselves with part-time courses at Tata Institute of Social Sciences. They were also sensitized on competitive exams like TET, NET and SET examinations. The session ended by educating them on how students could become members of different professional bodies.

5. Pre – Campus Presentation

Schools from different boards oriented the prospective student teachers about the schools HR policies and regulations, locations and branches of school if any.

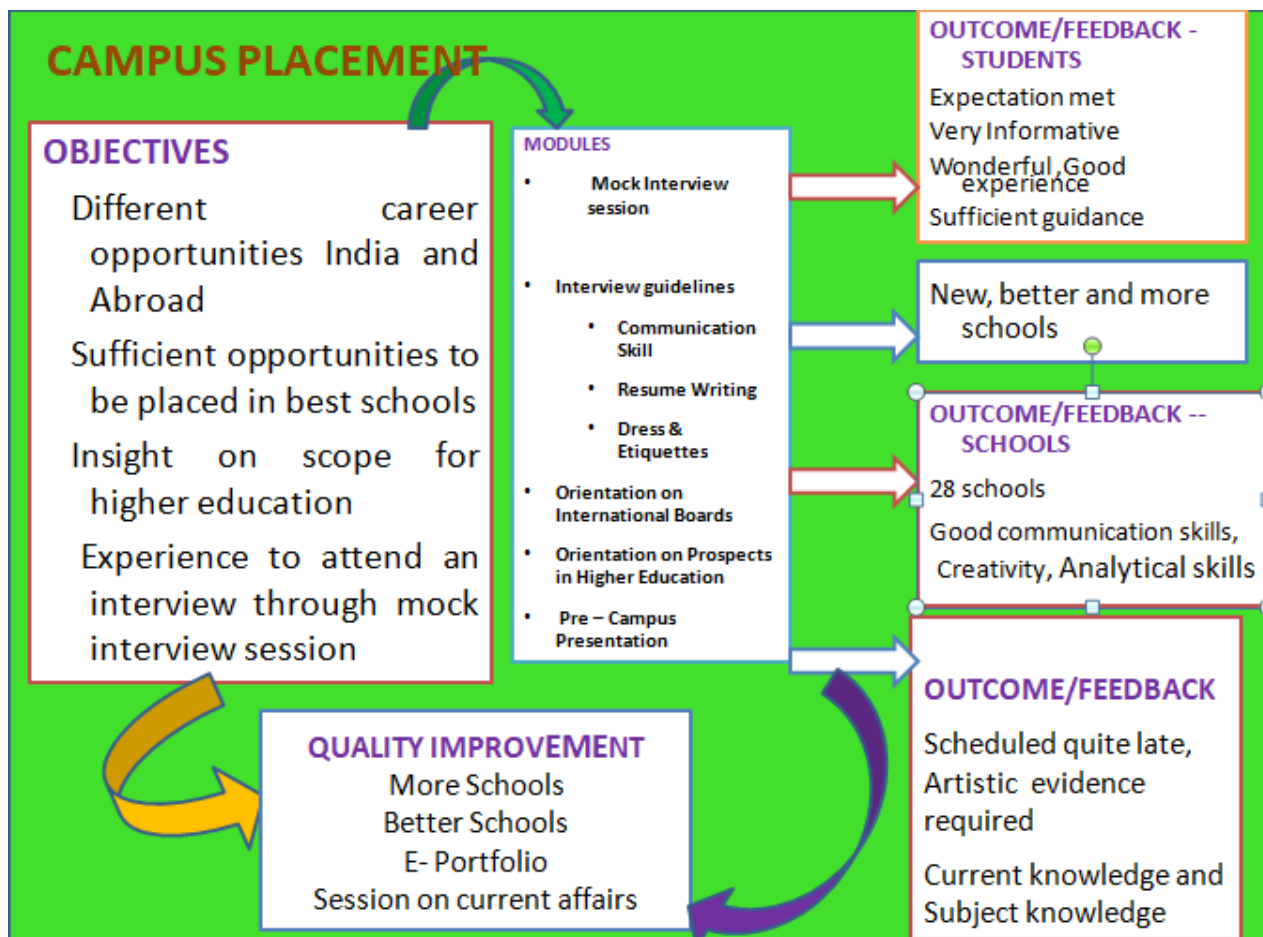
Campus recruitment was held on 27th February, 2019. 24 schools from central and western line and participated in the campus placement program. Different schools interviewed student teachers based on their requirement.
