CONCEPT NOTE

The Universal Apostolic Preferences (UAPs) are the four vital areas of action that all Jesuit institutions need to focus on. Educational institutions must be proactive in infusing these UAPs in their teaching-learning process. Each UAP seeks to strengthen the personal, professional and organizational transformation of an institution. The Ignatian Pedagogical Paradigm (IPP) is already a part of the teaching-learning process in Jesuit institutions. The UAP's would now need to be integrated in the teaching learning process, while following the IPP. It is therefore important to have greater insights about the UAP and the IPP. The main thrust of the Workshop would be to deepen the understanding of the UAPs and reflect, share, discern and respond to develop an action plan for Jesuit institutions.
